

Chapters 10-11 – The Glorious Church

Foundation Scriptures

Eph 5:26 Jesus wishes to sanctify and cleanse us with the washing of water by the word,

Eph 5:27 That He might **present us to Himself a glorious church**, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

Col 1:27 **Christ in you is the hope of glory.**

A. Overview

1. Power was transferred to satan.

Gen 1:26,28; 3:1-11 Adam sinned and turned his authority and dominion over to satan.

Luk 4:5 And the devil, taking him up into an high mountain, shewed unto him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time.

Luk 4:6 And the devil said unto him, All this power will I give thee, and the glory of them: for that is delivered unto me; and to whomsoever I will I give it.

2 Cor 4:4 So satan became the god of this world.

2. Jesus won back that power.

Col 2:15 *But Jesus defeated him by* having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it.

Matt 28:18 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

3. Jesus gave that power to the believer.

2Co 5:20 Now then we are ambassadors for Christ.

Mar 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

Mar 16:18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

Luk 10:17 And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name.

Luk 10:18 And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven.

Luk 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

4. The power is released through faith in the Name of Jesus.

Phi 2:10 That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of [things] in heaven, and [things] in earth, and [things] under the earth;

Act 3:16 And his name through **faith in his name** hath made this man strong,.

Rom 8:19 It is time for us to become the manifested sons and daughters of God.

B. Chapter 10 – Preparing to sound the Seventh Trumpet

1. The Little Book

Rev 10:1-3 And I saw another mighty angel And he had in his hand a **little book**.

2. The Glorious Church.

Rev 10:5 And the angel which I saw stand upon the sea and upon the earth

lifted up his hand to heaven, v 10:6 And swore by him that liveth for ever and

ever, who created heaven, and the things that therein are, and the earth, and the things that therein are, and the sea, and the things which are therein, that there should be **time no longer**:

Rev 10:7 But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the **mystery of God should be finished**, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets.

Col 1:26 [Even] the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to his saints:

Col 1:27 To whom God would make known what [is] the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is **Christ in you, the hope of glory**:

Col 1:28 Whom we preach, warning every man, and teaching every man in all wisdom; that we may present every man **perfect** in Christ Jesus:

Eph 4:11 And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; v 4:12 For the **perfecting** of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ:

Eph 4:13 Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a **perfect** man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:

Rom 5:8 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. v 5:9 Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be **saved from wrath** through him. v 5:10 For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life.

3. Sealing the Little Book.

Rev 10:4 And when the seven thunders had uttered their voices, I was about to write: and I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Seal up those things which the seven thunders uttered, and write them not.

Rev 10:8 -10 John is given the little book to eat.

4. Unsealing the Little Book.

Dan 10:14 Now I am come to make thee understand what shall befall thy people in the latter days: for yet the vision [is] for [many] days.

Dan 12:4 But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book, [even] **to the time of the end**: many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased.

Hab 2:14 For the earth shall be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea.

Matt 24:32 Now learn a parable of the fig tree; When his branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, ye know that summer [is] nigh:

Matt 24:33 So ye, when ye shall see all these things, know that it is near, [even] at the doors.

Matt 24:34 Verily I say unto you, **This generation shall not pass**, till all these things be fulfilled.

Matt 24:35 Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away.

1Co 10:11 Now all these things happened unto them for ensamples: and they are written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the world are come.

Hab 2:2 And the LORD answered me, and said, **Write the vision, and make [it] plain** upon tables, that he may run that readeth it.

C. Chapter 11 – The sounding of the Seventh Trumpet

1. The re-building of the Temple.

Rev 11:1 And there was given me a reed like unto a rod: and the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure the temple of God, and the altar, and them that worship therein.

Rev 11:2 But the **court which is without the temple leave out**, and measure it not; for it is given unto the Gentiles: and the holy city shall they tread under foot **forty [and] two months**.

2. The Two Witnesses – Two of the Glorious Church.

Rev 11:3 And I will give [power] unto my two witnesses, and they shall **prophecy** a thousand two hundred [and] threescore days, clothed in sackcloth. *(3 ½ years @ 30 days per month)*

Rev 11:4 These are the two olive trees, and the two candlesticks standing before the God of the earth. v 11:5 And if any man will hurt them, **fire proceedeth out of their mouth**, and devoureth their enemies: and if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed. v 11:6 These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.

2Ki 1:10 And Elijah answered and said to the captain of fifty, If I [be] a man of God, then let **fire come down from heaven, and consume thee** and thy fifty. And there came down fire from heaven, and consumed him and his fifty.

Note: At this point, the world is no longer under Grace. We, the believers, are under the Law but with the Holy Spirit; it is imperative that we do not take the mark of the beast.

3. Follow-on fruits.

Rev 11:7 And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them.

Rev 11:8 And their dead bodies [shall lie] in the street of the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, **where also our Lord was crucified**.

Rev 11:9 And they of the people and kindreds and tongues and nations shall see their dead bodies three days and an half, and shall not suffer their dead bodies to be put in graves.

Rev 11:10 And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because these two prophets tormented them that dwelt on the earth.

Rev 11:11 **And after three days and an half the Spirit of life from God entered into them**, and they stood upon their feet; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.

Rev 11:12 And they heard a great voice from heaven saying unto them, Come up hither. And they ascended up to heaven in a cloud; and their enemies beheld them.

Rev 11:13 And the same hour was there a great earthquake, and the tenth part of the city fell, and in the earthquake were slain of men seven thousand: and the remnant were affrighted, and gave glory to the God of heaven.

Rev 11:14 **The second woe** is past; [and], behold, the third woe cometh quickly.

Rev 9:12 The First Woe is the plague of locusts Rev 9:12

Rom 8:29 For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate [to be] conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the **firstborn among many brethren**.

1Co 15:20 But now is Christ risen from the dead, [and] become the firstfruits of them that slept.

1Co 15:21 For since by man [came] death, by man [came] also the resurrection of the dead.

4. The kingdoms of this world.

Rev 11:15 And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The **kingdoms of this world** are become [the kingdoms] of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever.

Rev 11:16 And the four and twenty elders, which sat before God on their seats, fell upon their faces, and worshipped God, v 11:17 Saying, We give thee thanks, O Lord God Almighty, which art, and wast, and art to come; because thou hast taken to thee thy great power, and hast reigned.

Rev 11:18 And the nations were angry, and thy wrath is come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that thou shouldest give reward unto thy servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear thy name, small and great; and shouldest destroy them which destroy the earth. v 11:19 And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the ark of his testament: and there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail.

Mat 22:44 The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, till I make thine enemies thy footstool?

Heb 10:12 But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God; v 10:13 From henceforth expecting till his enemies be made his footstool.

Heb 10:14 For by one offering he hath **perfected** for ever them that are sanctified.

Gal 3:2 This only would I learn of you, Received ye the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?

Gal 3:3 Are ye so foolish? having begun in the Spirit, are ye now made **perfect** by the flesh?

D. The Last Enemy

1. Death shall be destroyed.

1Cor 15:24 Then [cometh] the end, **when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to God**, even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power.

1Cor 15:25 For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet.

1Cor 15:26 The last enemy [that] shall be destroyed [is] death.

2. Death has been abolished.
2Ti 1:10 But is now made manifest by the appearing of our Saviour Jesus Christ, who hath **abolished death**, and hath brought life and immortality to light through the gospel:
3. Not all believers shall die.
1 Corinthians 15:51 Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,
1 Corinthians 15:51 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)
Take notice! I tell you a mystery (a secret truth, an event decreed by the hidden purpose or counsel of God). **We shall not all fall asleep [in death]**, but we shall all be changed (transformed)
1Th 4:15 For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive [and] remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep.
1Th 4:16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:
1Th 4:17 Then we which are alive [and] remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to **meet** the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.
4. Freed from the Law of sin and death.
Rom 8:1 [There is] therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.
Rom 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.
Rom 8:11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.
